### Day 1 : Pick up at Kilimanjaro Airport and visit to Momella

We will see from the first minute the impact of travelling with Trip to help as the money invested in the trip goes directly to the different social projects that the NGO has: schools, medical centres, orphanage and vocational training. With a bit of luck we will meet Cornelia, doctor and daughter of the founder, who spends long periods of time there running the day

to day running of the NGO. We will stay at Hillside Retreat, a charming little hotel in the middle of nature that belongs to the NGO.

### Day 2 : First Day of Safari - Exploring Tarangire National Park



After an early breakfast, we'll set off on the first day of your safari adventure, heading to the majestic **Tarangire National Park**. In the afternoon, we'll continue exploring deeper into the park, where you'll have the opportunity to see more of Tanzania's impressive wildlife diversity. Tarangire is a bird lover's paradise, with over **500 bird**

species recorded in the park. From colorful **lilac-breasted rollers** to majestic **martial eagles**, you'll be able to appreciate the incredible variety of avian life that thrives here.

As the day comes to a close, the golden light of the African sunset will cast a magical glow over the landscape, creating a perfect backdrop for photography. We'll make our way to **Tarangire Safari Lodge**, a beautiful lodge nestled within the park, offering stunning panoramic views of the surrounding wilderness. ## Day 3 : Safari day 2: Serengueti National Park

We'll also pass through areas where elephants and giraffes can often be seen grazing peacefully, while impalas and gazelles leap gracefully through the grasslands. Birdlife in the Serengeti is equally diverse, with species ranging from majestic **eagles** and **vultures** to vibrant **bee-eaters** and **weavers**.

Along the shores of the **soda lake**, you'll often see large flocks of **flamingos** wading in the water, their vibrant pink color adding a splash of brightness to the scene.
